Vsako leto si jo prizadevamo obogatiti z nekaj novimi umetninami, ki jih predstavimo domači in tuji javnosti. Letos smo na široko odprli vrata »novemu valu« mlajših ustvarjalk in ustvarjalcev, ki so v zbirko vnesli sodoben pridih in novo dinamiko.

## O novem valu v zbirkni About a new wave in the collection

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Mladi ustvarjalci premikajo svet likovne umetnosti in projekt »Novi val«, nabor umetnin mladih slovenskih avtorjev, ki bodo dopolnile umetniško zbirkzo Ministrstva za zunanjje zadeve Republike Slovenije, vnaša med sistematično zbrane slike svežino, sanje in nov ustvarjalni naboj iskalcev izvirnosti, prav tako pa trpkost časa, v katerega smo ujeti. Po likovnih zvrsteh in vsebinah tvorijo izbrana dela pestro umetniško paleto, od realistične do abstraktne umetnosti, od hiperrealizma do minimalizma in vse tja do umetnosti post-digitalne dobe. Pri izboru likovnikov smo sledili kvaliteti, različnosti in pa razpršenosti mladih zanimivih avtorjev po vseh slovenskih regijah. ## **Karmen BAJEC**

**1981, Šempeter pri Novi Gorici**


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Po končani Srednji šoli za oblikovanje in fotografijo v Ljubljani je vpisala študij slikarstva na ljubljanski Akademiji za likovno umetnost in oblikovanje pod mentorstvom prof. Metke Krašovec. Leta 2005 je pri njej diplomirala ter leta 2010 magistrirala pri prof. Bojanu Gorencu in prof. Metki Krašovec. Drugi letnik je zaključila na študijski izmenjavi v Tallinu v Estoniji. Leta 2010 je pridobila strokovno pedagoško-andragoško izobrazbo na Filozofski fakulteti v Ljubljani. Ukvarja se s slikarstvom, pedagoškim vodstvom, likovno kritiko in ilustracijo. Živi in ustvarja v Starem trgu pri Ložu. Njeno področje delovanja in raziskovanja je slikarstvo, ilustracija; raziskuje starodavno znanje, kot so arhetipi in simboli v geometrični abstrakciji in naravi. Pri tem uporablja svetlobo in prostor, barvo, ritem ter gibanje kot glavne likovne elemente in njih spremenljivke.

After finishing High School of Design and Photography in Ljubljana, she studied painting at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design in Ljubljana. She earned her bachelor's degree in 2005 and her master's degree in 2010 under the guidance of Prof. Metka Krašovec and Prof. Bojan Gorenc, respectively. She completed the second year of her master's degree programme through a study exchange in Tallinn, Estonia. In 2010, she concluded the pedagogical-andragogical study programme at the Faculty of Arts in Ljubljana. She is involved in painting, cultural management, art criticism, and art illustration. Her work and research focus on painting and illustration; she explores ancient knowledge, such as archetypes and symbols in geometric abstraction and nature. Light and space, colour, rhythm and movement, including their variables, are the main elements of her artistic expression. She lives and works in Stari trg pri Ložu.




## **Suzana BRBOROVIĆ**

**1988, Kranj**

2007–2012 – študira slikarstvo na Akademiji za likovno umetnost in oblikovanje v Ljubljani pri izr. prof. Bojanu Gorencu; 2012 – prejme študentsko Prešernovo nagrado; 2013 – diplomira iz slikarstva pri mentorju izr. prof. Bojanu Gorencu. Diploma z naslovom *Odsev zamika (Urbana krajina kot konstrukt med slikarstvom in družbeno-socialnim kontekstom)*; 2014 –en semester preživi kot gostujuča študentka na Akademiji za vizualno umetnost v Leipzigu (HGB) pri mentorju prof. Heribertu C. Ottersbachu; 2014–2016 – podiplomski mojstrski študij slikarstva (Meisterschüler) na Akademiji za vizualno umetnost v Leipzigu (HGB) pri mentorju prof. Heribertu C. Ottersbachu; trenutno dela in živi v Leipzigu. NAGRADE – izbor: 2019 – Jakopičeva priznanje, 2019 – Priznanje pomembnih umetniških del, 2012 – Akademska Prešernova nagrada, 2011 – ESSL ART AWARD CEE 2011, prva nagrada za Slovenijo.

Between 2007 and 2012, she studied painting at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design in Ljubljana under the guidance of Associate Prof. Bojan Gorenc, and received the Prešeren Award for students in 2012. In 2013, she graduated in painting under the guidance of Associate Prof. Bojan Gorenc, with the thesis entitled *The Reflection of Respite (Urban Landscape as a Construct between Painting and the Social Context)*. In 2014, she studied for one semester at the Academy of Visual Arts in Leipzig (HGB) under Prof. Heribert C. Ottersbach. In 2014–2016, she finished a two-year postgraduate programme at the Academy of Visual Art in Leipzig (Meisterschüler) (HGB) under the guidance of Prof. Heribert C. Ottersbach. She lives and works in Leipzig. Here is a selection of awards: 2019: the Jakopič Award; 2019: Recognition of important works of art; 2012: Prešeren Award for students; 2011: ESSL ART AWARD CEE 2011, first Slovenian award.

## **Sebastijan ČASAR**

**1981, Čakovec**

Likovna gimnazija v Sombotelu, smer grafika, Likovna pedagogika Sombotelu, magisterij Pécsi Tudományegyetem, smer slikarstvo. Mentorji: Nemes László, Masszi Ferenc, Bartek Péter Pál, Stekovics Gáspár. Vir navdiha mu predstavlja neposredno okolje lendavske panonske pokrajine. Njegov stil je bolj realističen, dela pa so bolj »barvno centrična« in presegajo pojem klasične upodobitve pokrajine. Pokrajina kot motiv je le rekvizit za to, da umetnik upodobi svoja najgloblja čutena. Z barvnimi kompozicijami lahko izraža misli, čustva, ideje, filozofije, veroizpovedi. Zaradi vtisa, ki ga delom daje pogumni izbor barv, se jih ne moremo naveličati. Umetniška dela odražajo človekovo bivanje in preko zunanjosti spoznavamo nevidni notranji svet ustvarjalca, ki je predstavnik mlajše generacije, ki se spopada z izzivi sodobnega časa in sodobne tehnologije, prav tako pa tudi bori za obstoj in razvoj tradicionalnega

He studied graphic design and art education at the Art High School in Sombotel and finished his master's degree in painting at the University of Pécs, Hungary, mentored by Nemes László, Masszi Ferenc, Bartek Péter Pál, and Stekovics Gáspár. He finds inspiration in the immediate environment of the Pannonian Plain around Lendava. He paints in a realistic style, but his »colour-centric« works go beyond the notion of classical landscape painting. The motif of landscape is merely a tool which he uses to portray his deepest feelings. His colour compositions are an expression of his thoughts, feelings, ideas, philosophy, and religion. The bold use of colours in his works leaves such a strong impression that one cannot get tired of them. His works reflect man's existence. Through their outer expression, we learn about the invisible inner world of the artist, who represents the younger generation, a generation facing the challenges of modern time and technology, while also fighting for the conservation and progress of the traditional.

## Sara ČEH

1995, Ptuj

Med letoma 2014 in 2017 je študirala slikarstvo na Šoli za risanje in slikanje Art House v Ljubljani; leta 2017 je diplomirala in tam trenutno nadaljuje podiplomski študij. Slika v tehniki akril in olje na platno, pogosto se izraža v asemblažih in trodimenzionalnih slikah, pri katerih posega po nekonvencionalnih materialih, ki jih vključuje na platna in v dela na papirju.

Za svoje delo je prejela priznanja (Art House študentsko priznanje); razstavlja na selekcioniranih razstavah: 2017 je imela pregledno samostojno razstavo v Tovarni umetnosti Majšperk.

Pogosto v kompozicije, ki sodijo bolj v svet abstrakcije in so na meji med mimetičnim in nemimetičnim slikarstvom, enakovredno vključuje fotografijo. Prav tako posega v svet lokalnih mitov in Kurent je pogosto lik, ki ga nenehno predeluje in dela na kombinaciji barve in, kljub abstrakciji, tudi forme.

In 2014–2017, she studied painting at Arthouse, College of Fine Arts in Ljubljana, and after graduating in 2017, she has continued her studies for a master's degree. She paints in acrylic and oil on canvas, frequently finding expression in assemblages and three-dimensional paintings by placing unconventional material on canvas and paper. She received the Arthouse student award and exhibits her work at selected exhibitions: In 2017, she had a solo survey exhibition at the Art Factory Majšperk.


In her compositions, which dive into the world of abstraction and sit somewhere on the boundary between the mimetic and non-mimetic painting, photography is often equally important as painting. She also draws from the world of local myths and constantly remakes the motif of Kurent, working on combinations of colour and, despite abstraction, also form.

## Bogdan ČOBAL

**1942, Zrenjanin**

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Bogdan Čobal se je rodil v izgnanstvu leta 1942 v Zrenjaninu v Vojvodini (v Srbiji). Slikarstvo je študiral na Akademiji za likovno umetnost v Ljubljani, kjer je leta 1967 diplomiral. Zaposlen je bil v prosveti kot pedagog predmetov likovne umetnosti in likovne vzgoje ter kot izredni profesor slikanja, risanja in likovne teorije na oddelku za slikarstvo Pedagoške fakultete Univerze v Mariboru. Imel je več samostojnih in skupinskih razstav doma in v tujini. Je predsednik Umetniškega sveta Društva likovnih umetnikov Maribor. Živi in ustvarja v Mariboru.

Bogdan Čobal was born in exile in Zrenjanin, Vojvodina (Serbia), in 1942. He studied painting at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design in Ljubljana and graduated in 1967. He has worked as an art teacher at various secondary schools and as an associate professor of painting, drawing and art theory at the Faculty of Education of the University of Maribor, Slovenia. He staged many solo and group exhibitions in Slovenia and abroad. He lives and works in Maribor, he is Chairman of the Fine Arts Council of the Maribor Fine Artists Society.

## **Barbara DREV**

**1986, Slovenj Gradec**

Barbara Drev se je rodila leta 1986 v Slovenj Gradcu. Leta 2006 se je vpisala na Akademijo za likovno umetnost in oblikovanje v Ljubljani, smer slikarstvo pri prof. Hermanu Gvardjančiču. Leta 2009/2010 je preko programa Erasmus nadaljevala študij na Hochschulle für Grafik und Buchkunst v Leipzigu, Nemčiji, pri prof. Inu Mellerju za obdobje enega semestra. Leta 2014 je diplomirala iz slikarstva pod mentorstvom izr. prof. Zmaga Lenárdiča. Od 2014 do 2017 je imela status samozaposlene v kulturi. Deluje na področju slikarstva in grafike. Živi in dela v Topolšici. Motivna izhodišča njenih slikarskih del so predvsem povezana z odnosom med družbo in tehnološkim napredkom, prepletom realnosti in fikcije (virtualnosti). Zanima jo abstraktna ideja tehnološkega napredka, v smislu, kako je sprva zamejil, nato zabrisal meje realnega. Vzpostavil se je digitalni, kiber prostor neslutenega pretoka informacij; dosežki tehničnih in celo naravoslovnih znanosti so začeli posegati celo na področje etike, industrija je vedno bolj prožna in preračunljiva, vedno bolj pa so vidni okolijski vplivi.

Barbara Drev was born in Slovenj Gradec in 1986. In 2006, she began to study painting at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design in Ljubljana with Prof. Herman Gvardjančič. In 2009–2010, she continued her studies for one semester under the Erasmus programme at the Academy of Fine Arts (Hochschule für Grafik und Buchkunst) in Leipzig, Germany, with Prof. Ingo Meller. In 2014, she graduated in painting under the guidance of Associate Prof. Zmago Lenárdič. Between 2014 and 2017, she held the status of self-employed artist in the cultural sector, and worked as a freelancer. She lives and works in Topolšica, engaging in painting and graphics. Her paintings are mostly inspired by the relationship between society and technological progress, the intertwining of reality and fiction (virtuality). She is interested in the abstract concept of technological progress, in how progress first marked and later blurred the boundaries of the real. A digital cyberspace has been created, enabling a previously unimaginable flow of information. The achievements of technological and also natural sciences have even started interfering with the ethics; industry is ever more flexible and self-interested, with environmental impacts becoming increasingly visible.

## **Maša GALA**

**1985, Kranj**

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Deluje na področjih slikarstva, instalacije steklenih objektov, grafike in fotografije. Zaključila je študij slikarstva, novih medijev in grafike na ALUO v Ljubljani, kjer je leta 2010 prejela študentsko Prešernovo nagrado za slikarstvo. Študijsko se je na področju avtorske fotografije izpopolnjevala na VŠUP v Pragi, na Češkem. Poleg samostojne prakse od leta 2010 deluje tudi v umetniški skupini 3kolektiv. Od leta 2005 razstavlja v Sloveniji in v tujini (Nizozemska, Francija, Češka, Bolgarija, Italija, Švica, Nemčija) na različnih samostojnih in skupinskih razstavah. Dela in živi v Ljubljani.

V svojih delih avtorica kombinira slikarsko risbo in ploskovite barvne nanose. Rezultat so abstraktne slikarske podobe, ki izhajajo iz oblik in obrisov konkretnega sveta in so hkrati tudi psihične opne njenih doživljaj. Zanimajo jo prostori, resnični in navidezni, njihovo plastenje ter njihovo delovanje glede na človekov dejanski položaj v njih, človekovo doživljanje le-tega in bivanje v njih kot izrazito doživljajsko izkustvo.

**She works in the areas of painting, glass installation, graphics, and photography. She graduated in painting, new media and graphics at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design in Ljubljana and received the Prešeren Award for students for painting in 2010. She perfected her studies of copyright photography at the Academy of Arts, Architecture and Design in Prague, Czech Republic. In addition to her independent practice, she has worked as a member of the artistic group 3kolektiv since 2010. Since 2005, her works have been displayed at solo and group exhibitions in Slovenia and abroad (the Netherlands, France, the Czech Republic, Bulgaria, Italy, Switzerland, Germany). She lives and works in Ljubljana.**

**Her works combine tonal drawing and layers of colours applied to a flat surface. This produces abstract painted images that arise from the shapes and outlines of the actual world. At the same time, they are mental veils of her experience. She is interested in spaces, real and imaginary, in their layering and impact in terms of an individual's actual position in them, in an individual's perception of spaces and living in them as a distinctly experiential activity.**

## Rok HORVAT

1993, Maribor

Rok Horvat je leta 2015 diplomiral na oddelku za slikarstvo Akademije za likovno umetnost in oblikovanje v Ljubljani, kjer zaključuje podiplomski študijski program slikarstva pod mentorstvom prof. Bojana Gorenca in prof. Sergeja Kapusa. V študijskem letu 2013/14 je prejel Prešernovo priznanje Akademije za likovno umetnost in oblikovanje. Vključen je bil v številne selekcionirane razstave: 2020 Galerija Equrna, Ljubljana; 2019 Galerija Layerjeve hiše in Stolpa Škrlovec, Kranj, Galerija MGLC, Ljubljana; 2018 Galerija sodobne umetnosti, Celje, Galerija Media Nox, Maribor; 2017 Galerija Equrna, Ljubljana; 2016 Galerija Media Nox, Maribor. Živi in dela v Ljubljani. Prof. Bojan Gorenec je o delu mladega avtorja med drugim dejal: »Če velja, da slikarstvo ni medij med mediji, pač pa da je poleg tega, da se izvršuje na sebi specifičen način, predvsem način mišljenja in delanja, iz katerega izhaja marsikaj, potem to posebej velja za Roka Horvata. ... Imel je in ima svojo agenda, svojo pot raziskovanja slikarstva onkraj podobe ali to-kraj podobe, če hočete. Njegove slike so definirane in stokrat premišljene na vseh delih površine, tega omejenega prostora svobode in odločitev. Aktualnost in zgodovina se prepleteta in nastajajo dela z izredno močnim izžarevanjem, posebna in edinstvena, vendar pa tudi znana in povezana z iskanjem bistvenega.«

Rok Horvat graduated in painting at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design in Ljubljana in 2015, where he is completing his postgraduate course in painting under the guidance of Prof. Bojan Gorenec and Prof. Sergej Kapus. In 2013–2014, he received the Prešeren Award for students at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design. He exhibited his works at numerous selected exhibitions: Equrna gallery, Ljubljana, 2020; Layer House and Stolp Škrlovec gallery, Kranj, MGLC gallery, Ljubljana, 2019; Gallery of Contemporary Art, Celje, Media Nox gallery, Maribor, 2018; Equrna gallery, Ljubljana, 2017; Media Nox gallery, Maribor, 2016. He lives and works in Ljubljana. Prof. Bojan Gorenec commented on the young artist's work: »If painting is not considered a medium among other media, but is, in addition to being executed in its own specific way, first and foremost a way of thinking and working, from which many things emerge, this is especially true for Rok Horvat. .... He has had his own agenda, his way of exploring painting on the other side of an image or, if you wish, on this side of an image. His paintings are exactly defined and thoroughly considered, every little part of their surface, this limited space of freedom and choice. Reality and history intertwine and give rise to works which emanate something powerful, special, and unique, yet so familiar and related to the quest for the “essential”.

## Milan KETIŠ

1992, Maribor

Študiral na ALUO, smer slikarstvo. V letu 2015 se je udeležil izmenjave na University of Arts Helsinki, Academy of Fine Arts, Painting department. Tekom študija je sprva raziskoval predvsem medij slikarstva in znotraj njega preizkušal raznotere možnosti, ki jih nudi. Najbolj ga je nagovarjala taktilnost barve, kar je privelo do uporabe naravnih materialov v slikanju. Glavni vir inspiracije mu je narava, natančneje sama prst, zemlja, ki jo uporablja v slikanju za doseganje različnih tekstur in reliefnosti slikarske površine. Najpomembnejše mu je eksperimentiranje s samim materialom, podobe so zaradi tega velikokrat podrejene poetiki materiala, mejijo na informel, hkrati pa se oddaljujejo od njega v svoji težnji po geometrijskosti in nakazujejo na op art. V preteklih letih je ustvarjal različne projekte, od performansa, inštalacije, prostorske ambientalne postavitve, objektov in slik. Trenutno se posveča slikarstvu in nadaljuje z raziskovanjem uporabe prsti. Glavna tema, s katero se ukvarja, je vprašanje, kako človeku približati naravo in preprostost naravnih materialov skozi umetnost.

Milan Ketiš studied at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design, study programme: Painting. In 2015, he took part in an exchange programme at the University of Arts Helsinki, Academy of Fine Arts, Painting Department. During his studies, he initially focused on painting, exploring the variety of possibilities it offers. He was drawn particularly to tactile paint, which led him to the use of natural materials in painting. His main source of inspiration is nature, the soil itself, which he uses in painting to achieve various textures and relief of the painting surface. He likes to experiment with the material itself; as a result, the images are often less important than the poetics of the material, bordering on art informel, while at the same time straying away from it in the desire for geometricity and reminding of optical art. In recent years, he has created various projects, from performance, installation, spatial installation, objects, and paintings. He is currently focused on painting and continues to explore the use of soil. His main theme is how to bring nature and the simplicity of natural materials closer to man through art.




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
**Alja KOŠAR**

Njena likovna govorica je zelo prepoznavna – kombinacija sveže, ekspresivne, poslikane površine in risbe v obliki čečkarije, katere orisani trakovi (kolaži) segajo in izstopajo čez rob slike. Plastenje barvnih nanosov gradi intuitivno. Poskuša odpirati prostor v novo dimenzijo, intimni nivo, s katerim želi artikulirati s publiko. Spojiti nespoljljivo in bogatiti in razvijati likovno govorico. Ohranja klasično, štafelajsko slikarstvo skozi osnovne likovne elemente in likovne smeri.

## **Marjeta MEDVED**

**1982, Ljubljana**

Diplomirala je leta 2009 na Akademiji za likovno umetnost in oblikovanje v Ljubljani, smer kiparstvo pri prof. Juriju Smoletu, in je aktivna članica Društva likovnih umetnikov Ljubljana. V prostoru, v katerem ustvarja in živi v sožitju z naravo, v lastni režiji proučuje politeistično staro slovansko mitologijo, ki je sicer drugače v likovnem svetu pri nas slabo raziskana, a je bogata in prepolna bajeslovnih bitij, Rojenic, Sojenic, Ajdov, Zlatorogov in drugih likov, ki jih najdemo v ljudskih pripovedkah. Podobe in oblike nastajajo pri klesanju in prihajajo neposredno izpod avtorične roke. Podrejajo si obliko lesa, ki ga obuja k življenju in neizprosno postavi na ogled, in njene skulpture so, kot bi izhajale iz umetničinega pra-spomina ali pa iz neke primarne biti, istočasno pa so vseskozi povezane z zgodbami in liki iz preteklih obdobij, ki jih oblikuje v sodobne lesene ekspresivne skulpture. Medvedova se spoprijema tudi z likovno površino platen, ki jih polni z nanosi barve in preproste forme in na katerih zasledimo abstraktne krajine, ki pa vseskozi poudarjajo in nas opozarjajo, da jih je izdelala kiparka.


**She graduated from the Academy of Fine Arts and Design in Ljubljana in 2009 under the mentorship of Prof. Jurij Smole and is an active member of the Ljubljana Fine Artists Society. In the space in which she creates and lives in harmony with nature, she independently studies polytheistic Slavic mythology, which is relatively poorly researched in the Slovenian art world. However, it is rich and full of mythical beings, such as rojenice (deities of birth), sojenice (deities of fate), ajdi (giants), Zlatorog (Goldhorn) and other characters found in folk tales. The images and shapes are created in carving and come to life by the author's hand. They master the shape of the wood that she brings to life and relentlessly puts on display. Her sculptures seem to be derived from the artist's primeval memory or from some primary being, while they are also always reminiscent of stories and characters from past periods, which she shapes into modern expressive wooden sculptures. She also works on the artistic surface of the canvas, covering it with coatings of paint and simple forms that depict abstract landscapes, a constant reminder that they were created by a sculptor.**

During her first post-graduate years, she was mostly interested in the question of identity and authenticity as the ideological driving force behind the individualism of the modern person. This resulted in a series of paintings entitled *Seekers*, presented at the Hest Gallery and Media Nox Gallery, as well as in several group exhibitions. Through her creative work, Silvia is trying to find an answer to the long-lasting question of the most important and the most valuable purpose of human existence. For the philosopher Charles Guignon, achieving this ideal, the goal of every person, was about the following: "To be authentic, one must first be true to one's real self. One must be what one can be and become what one truly is." Through her fine art, Silvia seeks to do just that. The philosopher's words are close to her heart and she believes that a person's true essence is hidden within.

**1992, Jesenice**


